3. Effective **Monday, 10/12/09**, there will be **No Parking** available in **Lot 1** and **Lot 2A** due to construction of the new Administration of Justice Building.
4. Effective **Sunday 10/4/09** through **Friday 11/20/09**, overnight work will be taking place in the Administration Building to install new mechanical piping.



5. On **Tuesday, 11/03/09**, construction trailers will be set up in Lot 1 and Lot 2A for the start of construction of the Administration of Justice Building.
