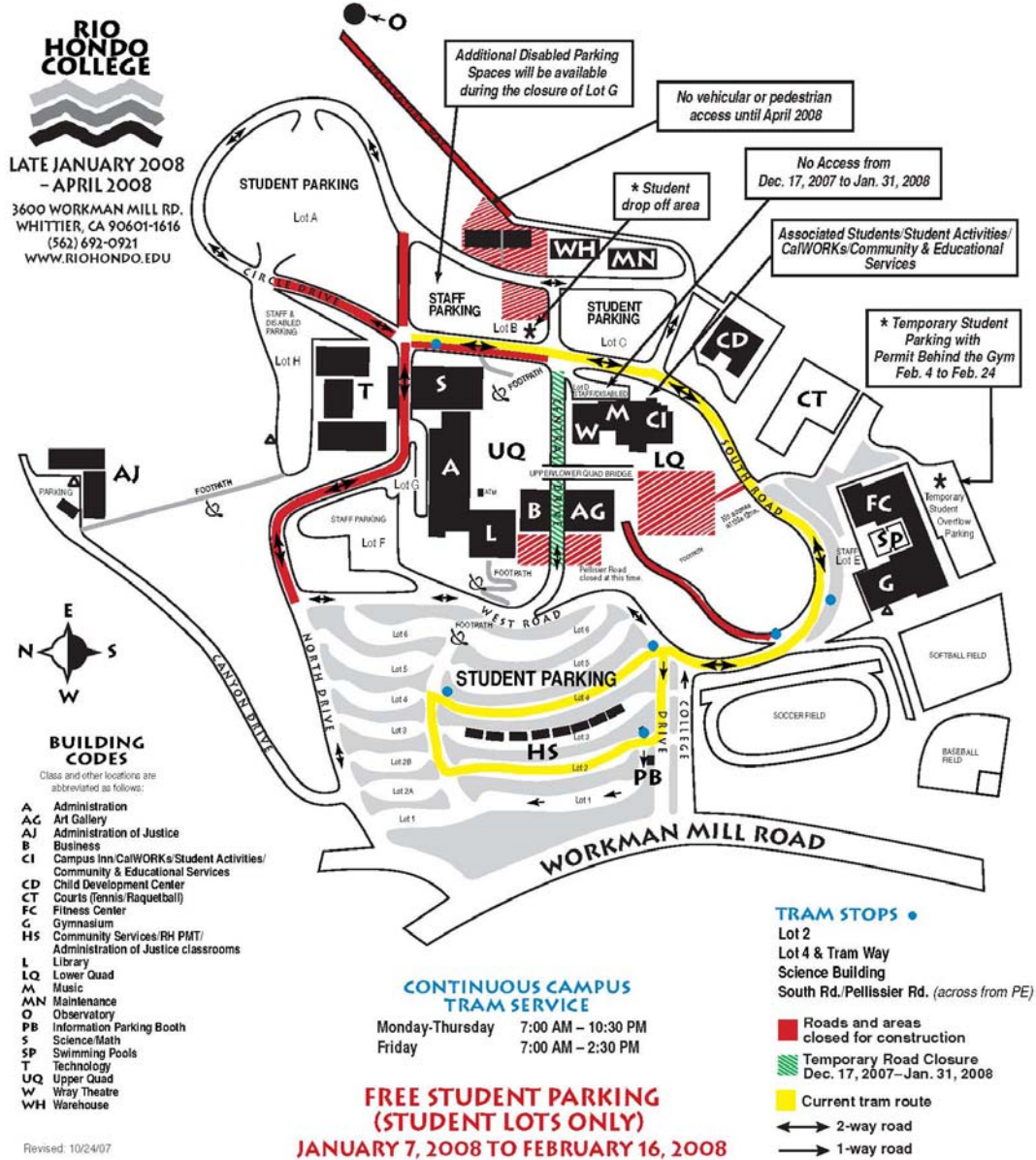


* IMPORTANT NOTICE *

Construction related to the Rio Hondo College Building Access and Excellence building program is now underway!

Over the next several years, the College will issue campus maps on a regular basis which show roads and areas closed due to construction, as well as updated tram routes/stops. This campus map is for the period of **Late January 2008 through April 2008**. Please consider these changes when planning your route to the campus and your parking plans. Directional signs will be placed around the campus to ensure safe circulation. The Campus Tram will not be stopping at Lots A or H from Late November 2007 through March 2008. WELCOME BACK!**

As you may have observed, the College is well underway on a building program which will provide new facilities for use by students, faculty and staff. The initial phase of projects includes the Library/LRC, Central Plant, Utility Infrastructure, and Pedestrian Bridge. To enable construction to proceed on these projects, several roadways have been closed and traffic circulation has been revised. The map provided below depicts these changes. In addition, maps have been posted in hallways and many classrooms.

As identified on campus maps, the major changes in circulation which will take place during the week of January 21, 2008 include the following:

- Opening of Circle Drive East (in front of the Maintenance/Warehouse buildings)
- Closure of North Drive between West Road and Circle Drive West
- Closure of stairs from Lot A to Intersection of North Dr. and Circle Dr.; rerouting of pedestrian travel from Lot A through the Technology lot.
- Closure of Parking Lot G

In addition, the opening of Central Drive and the Wray Theater Parking Lot will take place on or before February 1, 2008.

Campus security officers will direct vehicle and pedestrian traffic at specified locations throughout the campus. To facilitate faculty/staff recognition, when you arrive on campus, please display your faculty/staff parking permit so that it may be viewed by officers as you approach. The number of security officers has been increased to assist in directing traffic.

The road construction, coupled with the first week's traffic, will impact our travels throughout the campus. Your patience and cooperation will be greatly appreciated during this time. If you are able to carpool with other members from the campus community, this would facilitate the ease of parking on campus.
