Construction Work Update

CAUTION:

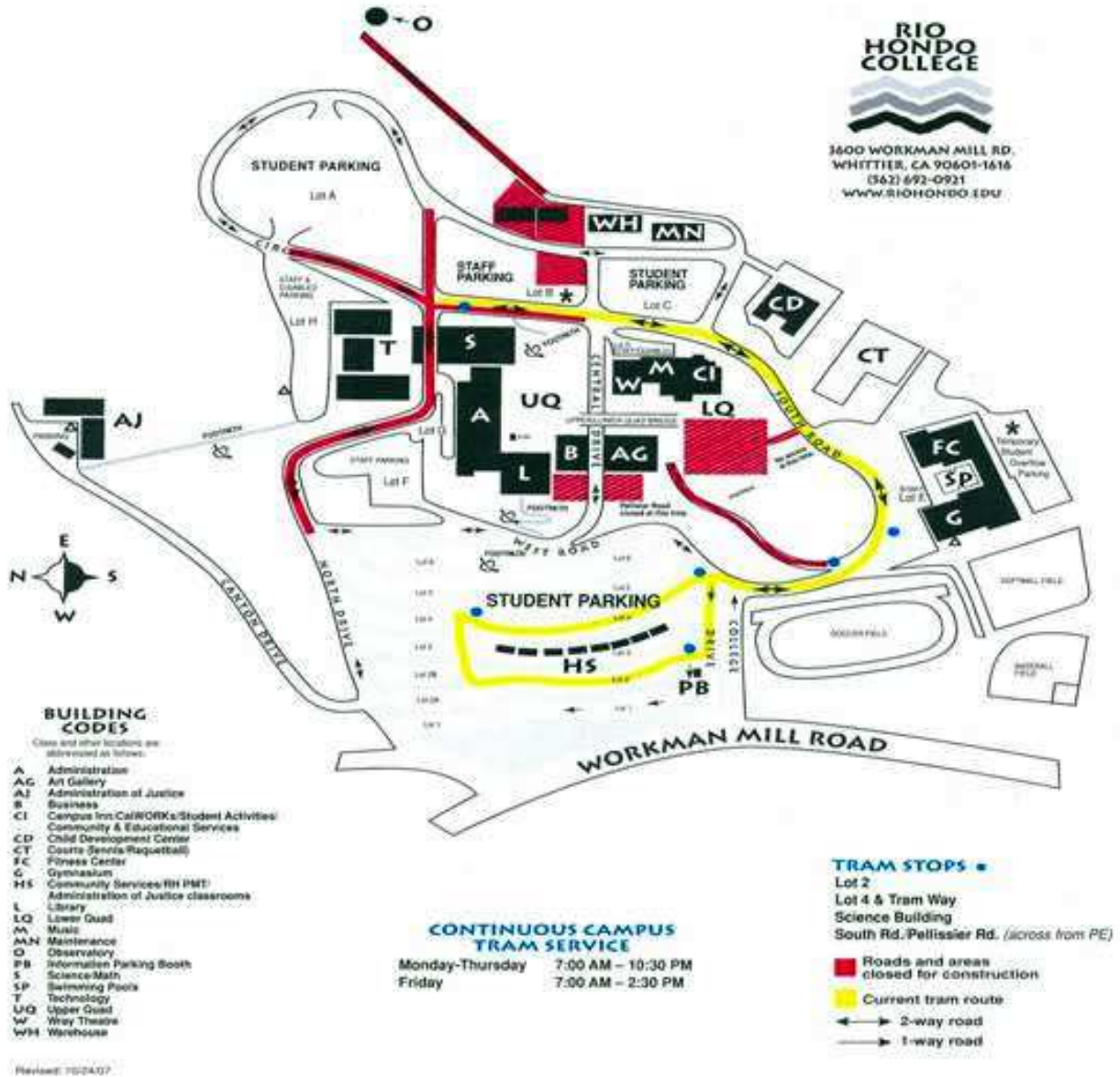
1. On May 28th, concrete trucks will be on North Drive, West Road and Central Drive going to the Library/LRC site.
2. Throughout the month of May, the Library/LRC site will receive early morning material deliveries between 5:00 AM and 7:00 AM.
3. Planned electrical power shut down to the entire campus starting at 10:00 p.m. on May 30th thru 6:00 p.m. on June 1st, for the LLRC and Infrastructure projects.
4. Tenant Improvement work is ongoing. The restrooms in the Library Basement will be out-of-service during this work.
5. On Friday, May 23rd, Southern California Edison (SCE) will be working in electrical yard directly behind Parking Lot H.
6. On May 30th, two flatbed trucks will be traveling on North Road, through Lot 4, on South Road, and on Central Drive to deliver large pieces of lumber to the LLRC site.
7. On May 30th, trucks will be on North Drive dropping asphalt at the upper portion of North Drive.
8. On May 30th, some concrete trucks will be on South Road and Circle Drive going to Lot H for electrical encasement.

Ongoing: Periodically, some classrooms may experience a louder volume of noise due to construction activity. We will do our best to notify in advance the area's that will be affected by this.

The following construction activities will take place during next week starting on **Friday 05/23/08** through **Friday 05/30/08** from 6:00am to 4:00pm (Day work) unless noted otherwise below.

Description	Approximate Completion Date
1) Infrastructure Phase 2 – working in Parking Lot G, west end of Parking Lot H, portions of North Drive and the Tech Quad	2008
2) Maintenance Facility Project –punch list work and close out	2008
3) Library and Learning Resource Center – portions of Lower Quad will be closed	2009
4) Central Plant – retaining walls and underground mechanical	2009
5) Pedestrian Bridge at Lot A – Seal coating the deck, bridge lighting	2008
6) Tenant Improvement – Library Basement and Campus Inn room CI-155	2008

As you may have observed, the College is well underway on a building program which will provide new facilities for use by students, faculty and staff. The initial phase of projects includes the Library/LRC, Central Plant, Utility Infrastructure, and Pedestrian Bridge. To enable construction to proceed on these projects, several roadways have been closed and traffic circulation has been revised. The map provided below depicts these changes.
